RE: Cool Creek Drain, Clark and Inman Arm

Attached is a petition and plans for the proposed reconstruction of Clark and Inman Regulated Drain located in the Cool Creek Watershed in Westfield, IN. The reconstruction is being proposed by Bellecrest Inc. The reconstruction is per plans by Stoeppelwerth and Associates, having Job No. 92255 DRE-S1 and dated 6/22/2021 (See Pages C602 to C603).

The Clark and Inman drain is a farm tile located within the Cool Creek Watershed and is currently maintained by Hamilton County. The drain was constructed per its original 1909 description.

The portion of the Clark and Inman Drain to be vacated and replaced will run from Sta. 0+0 to station 6+00 per the drains 1909 description. The new drain will be constructed in the form of reinforced concrete pipe and Lake #1 per the Stoeppelwerth plans.

The reconstructed drain begins at station 0+0 per the drains 1909 description and runs Southwest from Str. 432 to Str. 431 with 217 feet of 36" RCP before outletting into Lake #1 per the plans. Lake #1 then runs Southwest for 465 feet before outletting at Str. 401 per the plans. The drain then runs for 261 linear feet from Str. 401 to Str. 402 for 261 feet with 36" RCP before outletting into the existing Lake #6 of the Lakes at Grassy Branch per the plans.

The 36" RCP between

The reconstructed drain shall consist of the following:

36" RCP 478 feet

Open Ditch 455 feet

The total length of the reconstructed drain will be 933 feet. The proposal will increase the length of regulated drain by 333 feet.

Lake #1 per the plans are to be considered part of the regulated drain as a detention pond. Maintenance of the area assumed by the Drainage Board shall include the inlets and outlets of the reconstructed drain and ensuring that the flow of water is maintained as well as the storage volume, thus allowing no encroachments. The maintenance of the ponds such as sediment removal, erosion control along the banks, mowing and aquatic vegetation maintenance and control will be the responsibility of the developers or property owner. The overall cost of reconstruction will be paid by Bellecrest Inc.

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for urban drain classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designed as an urban drain.

I recommend that upon approval of the above proposed drain that the Board also approve the attached non-enforcement request. The nonenforcement is for the altering of the regulated drain easement widths as shown in the above referenced plans and secondary plat designed by Stoeppelwerth and Associates Inc. An offsite easement has been granted with the reconstruction of the Clark and Inman drain and is located on the following parcel: 08-06-29-00-00-028.000 owned by Roudy1 LLC. After approval by the Drainage Board, a survey (Job No. 92255DRE-S1) detailing the offsite easement will be recorded along with the plat.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposed drain for June 27, 2022.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the Cool Creek Drain, Clark and Inman Arm

be and is hereby declared established.

Re: Cool Creek Drain: Clark and Inman Drain-Belle Crest Reconstruction

Attached are as-built, certificate of completion & compliance, and other information for Belle Crest Reconstruction. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes were made to the drain, which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain-dated February 13, 2022. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held June 27, 2022. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 20, Pages 452-454) The changes are as follows: the 36" RCP was shortened from 478 feet to 435 feet. The open drain was lengthened from 455 feet to 460 feet. The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now **895 feet**.

The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on June 27, 2022 and recorded under instrument #2022058399. The following sureties were guaranteed by Forum Credit Union and released by the Board on its January 23, 2023 meeting.







Available water capacity is moderate (7.6 inches in the upper 60 inches). he pH of the surface layer in non-limed areas is 6.6 to 7.3. This soil is hydric. Droughtiness and wetness are management concerns for crop production. This soil responds well to tile drainage.
