" " " " " Stone retaining wall built from field rock laid up in mortar made from 1 pt Portland cement to 3 pts of good sharp sand. Dimensions 10 x 2 x 6 ft = $4\frac{1}{2}$ Cu. Recently while preparing the Delaware Township Drainage Map, I uncovered additional information which was unknown until this time. This concerns the length of the Craig, location of the Bradburn, non-existance of the Manship and additional length of the White. The following is for furture reference.

James Bradburn Drain, 1882 was an open drain consisting of an main ditch 5300 feet in length and a 100 foot Arm. 1500 feet of the main was later part of the Craig in 1899 and is included with that drain. In 1910 the Bradburn was tiled and consisted of 3900 feet of main ditch and a 100 foot Arm. The tile drain more or less followed the open ditch. This 1910 repair is also known as the Noah Manship.

The R.J. Craig was constructed in 1899 and consisted of 11,420 feet of main and 1420 feet of Arm.

The George White was constructed in 1916 and consists of 3660 feet main, 154 feet Arm 1 and 325 feet Arm 2.

In 1951 the system consisting of all 3 drains was repaired. At this time Arm 3 was added to the White consisting of 1275 feet and approximately 2450 feet of open ditch was added to the Craig.

In 1979 part of the White & Bradburn was reconstructed. This consisted of re-tiling 90 foot of the Bradburn and vacating 100 feet of the White. Of the 100 foot vacated, 40 foot was relocated so the length of the White was reduced by only 60 feet.

In 1982 part of the White and Bradburn Drains were again reconstructed. In this case 320 feet of the White and 340 feet of the Bradburn was vacated. Also 327 feet of the Bradburn & White was combined and relocated, 77 feet was added to Arm 1 of the White, 79 feet was added to the main White and 30 feet was added to the Bradburn. This involved the total reduction in footage of 164 feet of the White and if you add the combined portion of both drains to the Bradburn its length increases 17 feet.

Therefore, the lengths of these drains including mains and Arms are as follows.

The report of the viewers was favorable and was filed.

Report of R.D.Horney, County Surveyor, who was appointed to supervise the construction of above drain, would respectfully report that he has made a survey of the above drain and did proceed and definitely determine the best and cheapest method of drainage, the terminal and route, location, character of the proposed work, and fix the same by metes and bounds, courses and distances and descriptions, including grades and bench marks, including all necessary arms, estimated the cost thereof, divided the drain or ditch into sections of not more than one hundred feet in length, and computed and set out the number of cubic yards of excavation in each section, assessed the benefits of damages as the case may be, to each separate tract of land in the watershed to be affected thereby and to easements held by railways or other public or private corporations, or towns, including any land rights, easements, or water power, injuriously or beneficially affected, and do make report to the court under oath.

LOCATED in Delaware Township, beginning in the Town of Fishers, Hamilton County, Indiana, thence in a southerly and southwesterly course terminating in an open branch

approximately 60 rods east of the southwest corner of section 1, township 17 north, range 4 east.

After a careful investigation of the drainage now in place we would

RECOMMEND the open ditch known as the R.J.Craig Ditch be reconstructed, establish a new alignment and grade and extended to a point 50 feet south and approximately 70 rods east of southwest corner of section 1, township 17 north, range 4 east, from Sta 0 to Sta 41 or Nickle Plate Railroad, 3 foot bottom from Railroad right-of-way to Sta ~~56~~⁵¹⁰ terminus 4 foot bottom, terminating in open branch. Clear all shrubs, and brush from banks on each side, pile brush and burn, all limbs overhanging ditch or field to be cut. All mud, slush, boulders or other material to be deposited not nearer than ~~No Brush or shrubs to be covered unless authorized by Eng.~~ 5 feet from break of bank. All excavated material to be leveled with some mechanical equipment. All fences to be taken down and replaced by the Contractor. He shall not buy any new material for replacements. The slopes where new cuts are made to be $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 1, in old cuts the slope shall be made to conform with old slopes with least amount of damage. Clean out from under all railroad, County and private bridges, also the two pipes under railroad, also clean entrance and outlet to pipes under railroad.

TILE DITCHES

There are two tile drain systems which are in need of repair.

The James Bradburn was constructed about 1910 consisting of 12" tile throughout, terminating in R.J.Craig Open Ditch. This Drain is in bad repair. The headwall needs repairing. In many places the tile are broken. The inlet at Sta 0 needs repair.

About 1917 there was another tile ditch constructed known as the George W. White ditch starting at or near the Bradburn ditch serving approximately the same land and same water shed. This ditch consists of one row of 20" tile terminating in the R.J.Craig Open Ditch. There are tile broken in several places. Headwall needs repairing, open inlets cleaned out and repaired, new grates on some of the openings. Check and clear obstruction in tile.

Build new inlet at end of White Ditch. 4'x4' concrete and make connection to all drains, 24" grating on top. Connect the catch basin or inlet of the Blackburn and White Drains with 12" pipe. New manhole at Bradburn. Repair Jt box where Bradburn and White intersect. New cast iron grate on Jt Box.

ARM 3. Now in place

Commencing at a point near northwest corner of lot #34 in S. Fishers Addition to Fishers; thence south on east side of Street intersecting the George White ditch at approximately 40 feet north of the southwest corner of lot 7 in Kimberlain Addition, a distance of approximately Sta 1275.0 feet.

This ditch has several open inlets indicating obstruction. It shall be opened up and cleared of all obstructions. All open inlets to be cleaned and all cross connections to be cleaned of all obstructions.

There are several open inlets located along Main Street east of railroad; they shall be opened and outlets cleared and repaired.
