Attached is a petition, non-enforcement request, plans, calculations, quantity summary and assessment roll for the Flat Fork Creek Drain, Flatrock Creek Arm. I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages, and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

36" RCP 105 Ft

Open Ditch 820 Ft

The total length of the drain will be 925 feet. This is from the Hamilton-Hancock County Line to Flat Fork Creek as shown on Sheet 12 of the construction plans for Flatrock Creek, Section 1, prepared by Pendleton Consulting dated March 23, 2000, last revised June 5, 2000.

The retention pond (lake) located within the length of the open ditch is to be considered part of the regulated drain, and will be maintained as part of the regulated drain. The Board will also, retain jurisdiction for ensuring the storage volume for which the lake was designed will be retained. Thereby, allowing no fill or easement encroachments.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I also believe that no damages will result to landowners by the construction of this drain. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$25.00 per lot, \$10.00 per acre for roadways, with a \$25.00 minimum. With this assessment

the total annual assessment for this drain/this section will be \$1,658.00.

Parcels assessed to this drain may be assessed for the Flat Fork Creek or Fall Creek Drain at sometime in the future.

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

I recommend that upon approval of the above proposed drain that the Board also approve the attached non-enforcement request. This request is for the reduction of the regulated drain easement to those widths as shown on the attached exhibit to be recorded in the office of the Hamilton County Recorder.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for for August 28, 2000.


