Attached is a petition filed by the Marina Limited Partnership along with a non-enforcement request, plans, calculations, quantity summary and assessment roll for the Hampton Cove Drain to be located in Fall Creek Township, Hamilton County, Lawrence Township, Marion County and Vernon Township, Hancock County. I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages, and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

12" RCP 1,089 ft

15" RCP 267 ft

18" RCP 393 ft

The total length of the drain will be 1,749 feet.

The subsurface drains (SSD) under the private streets in Blocks A and B are not to be considered part of the regulated drain.

I recommend that lots 3A and B, 4A and B, 5A and B and 6A and B be assessed as one lot. Assessments for these lots should be through Hancock County. I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. I also believe that no damages will result to landowners by the construction of this drain. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$10.00 per acre for common areas and platted lots, \$10.00 per acre for roadways with a \$120.00 minimum. With this assessment the total annual assessment for this drain/this section will be \$720.00 for Hamilton County and \$1,920.00 for Hancock County, For ATOTAL ANNUAL COLLEGION OF \$2,440.00.

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

On December 20, 2001 the Hancock County Drainage Board waived its right to a Joint Drainage Board per IC 36-9-27-14. (See letter dated January 16, 2002 from David Smoll, Hancock County Surveyor) At this time Marion County has been requested to waive its rights to a Joint Board.
