


Re: Franklin B. Hunter Drain

Enclosed is a drain map of the Franklin B. Hunter Drain. At this time the open ditch which is within Hamilton County is not on a maintenance program. This ditch is number 12 on the Hamilton County classification list for maintenance.

I am writing to determine if Tipton County would desire to create a joint drain for maintenance. This drain would include the Franklin Hunter open and the John Snowberger tile in Hamilton County and the Hunter, Shaffer, Snowbarger and Gaiser tile drains in Tipton County. At this time I believe the open portion of the Hunter Drain within Hamilton County is the only drain not on a maintenance program.

Please let me know if interest exists in this matter. If so, further details can be worked out. If not, my recommendation to the Hamilton County Drainage Board will be to include the Hunter Drain with the Snowberger Drain which is now on maintenance.

At this time, the Tipton County Drainage Board does not wish to create a joint drain for maintenance with Hamilton County for the Franklin B. Hunter Drain. The Tipton County Drainage Board would like to continue, as in the past, with each county maintaining their portion of the subject drain located within their county boundaries. You will recall that in previous similar situations, each county has assessed only those affected landowners within their respective counties. Thus, we would expect that Tipton County landowners would not be assessed by Hamilton County.
