Represents that he is seized
in fee simple of the following

the best and cheapest manner
with out affecting the Lands of others
he claims that such drainage can
be best had by a ditch Commenc-
ing at or near the north line
of said tract of Land and running
there in a general South
Eastwesterly Course or direction
untill it shall reach Littlecreek
Creek he claims also that a
proper ditch to accomplish
such drainage would affect the
following Lands in Hamilton

and Tipton Counties State of
Indiana in addition to the land
above described and mentioned, viz
the North East and South-East
quarters of the South West quarter
of section 33 Township 21 Range 4
East in Tipton County owned by John Hunter
