

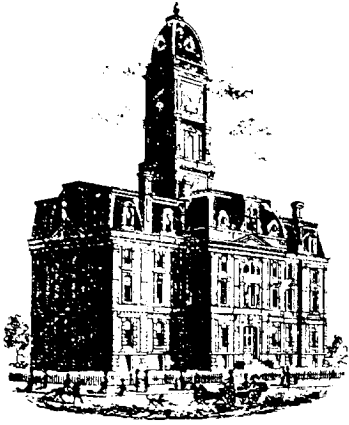

Re: Hunters Creek Village Drain Reconstruction, Oak Ridge Road Improvements

Attached are petition, plans, and other information for the Oakridge Road Improvement project. The reconstruction was submitted by the City of Carmel. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this project has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

This report will serve as an initial and final report for this construction. This road project installed a roundabout at the intersection of Bennett and Oak Ridge Roads. During this construction the Hunter's Creek Village regulated drain was affected. The changes are as follows:

**Hunter's Creek Village Drain**

**Hunter's Creek Village Section 1:** The project removed a portion of the existing drain as shown on plans prepared by Schneider Engineering Corporation dated August 12, 1982 from Structures 202-133, 132-130, 130-131 and 130 to a new manhole 151C which was set on the existing run between Structure 130 to 129. This Structure (151C) is shown on the plans for the Oak Ridge Road Improvements prepared by GAI Consultants dated April 29, 2004, Job No. 2004-161-10 on Sheet 26. Thus, the improvements removed 167 feet of 15", 18", and 21" RCP. Therefore, this project removed 167 feet from the drain's overall length.

Upon approval of the reconstruction I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.

The work was completed within the right of way owned by the City of Carmel and paid for by the City. Therefore, the project falls under the requirements as set out in IC 36-9-27-52.5. I recommend the Board approve the project at this time.

PETITION FOR RELOCATION AND RECONSTRUCTION

The City of Carmel (hereinafter "Petitioner"),  
hereby petitions the Hamilton County Drainage Board for authority to re-  
locate and improve a section of the Hunter Creek Village Drain,  
and in support of said petition advises the Board that:

1. Petitioner owns real estate through which a portion of the  
Hunter Creek Village Drain runs.
2. Petitioner plans to develop its real estate with roads, buildings,  
utilities, storm drains, sanitary sewers and other structures.
3. Petitioner's proposed development of its real estate will require  
relocation and reconstruction of a portion of the Hunter Creek Village  
Drain, as specifically shown on engineering plans and specifications  
filed with the Hamilton County Surveyor.
4. The work necessary for the proposed relocation and reconstruction  
will be undertaken at the sole expense of the Petitioner and such  
work will result in substantial improvement to the Hunter Creek Village  
Drain, without cost to other property owners on the watershed of  
the Hunter Creek Village Drain.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner requests that an Order issue from the Hamilton  
County Drainage Board authorizing relocation and reconstruction of the  
Hunter Creek Village Drain, in conformance with applicable  
law and plans and specifications on file with the Hamilton County Surveyor.
