



# REPORT OF COMMISSIONERS.

To the Honorable Judge of the Hamilton Circuit Court:

The undersigned, Commissioners of Drainage, to whom was referred the petition of Lewis Oberer for the drainage of the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section <sup>by</sup> Township 19 North of Range 5 East

in Hamilton County, respectfully report that they have inspected personally all the lands described in said petition, and all other lands liable to be affected by the construction of the proposed work, and are of the opinion that the proposed drainage will improve the public health of that neighborhood, will be a public utility, will benefit two public highways, and that the same can be constructed at an expense less than the aggregate benefits to the lands affected hereby, and after causing the necessary surveys and examinations to be made they determine that the method of drainage should be as follows, to wit:

They estimate the cost of constructing the work at four hundred and Twenty ~~35~~ dollars. They further report that they have estimated the benefits and injury

To the Honorable Board of Commissioners of

*Hamilton County, Indiana:*

We, the undersigned, appointed by this Court, at its June Reg., Term, 1902, to view a drain described in the certified

copy of a petition and order of Court for a Drain, by Jacob G Kepner and others,

handed us by the Auditor, would represent that according to said order we, on the day named therein, to wit: The 16<sup>th</sup> day

of June, 1902, in company with J. A. Mitchell, a civil engineer, made an accurate

survey of the line of said proposed Drain, from its source to its outlet. A plat of said Drain is filed herewith,

including the survey by the engineer, marked "Exhibit B." We caused stakes to be set along said line, each one hundred feet, numbering

down stream, as shown by plat. We also made a computation of the total number of cubic yards of earth to be removed from said drain, and

estimated the total cost for the construction of the work at Nine hundred Seventy  $\frac{27}{100}$  (\$70  $\frac{27}{100}$ ) Dollars.

We also apportioned and set apart to each parcel of land a share of said work in proportion to the benefits received, all of which will fully appear

by a tabular statement in this report. We have also set out, by a statement below, the names of the owners of lands benefited, with a description

of each tract of land, and the amount assessed against each tract. The depth of cut, the width at bottom, and width at top along said drain, is

also shown in a tabular statement in this report. After a full and careful view and examination, we are of the opinion that the drain, as located

by the survey, will be of public utility and that the cost of the construction

of the same will be less than the benefits to be derived therefrom  
and that said drainage can best be accomplished by a tile  
drain from Stake 0 to Stake 44<sup>15</sup> and an open drain from Stake 44<sup>15</sup> to  
Stake 46<sup>70</sup>. or terminus and an arm of 675 feet tiled throughout

The following statement shows who are benefited, the lands thereof and assessments thereon, location, length of each share, amount of assessments, amount of benefits, amount of dirt to be removed from each share, price thereof per cubic yard, and total cost of each share.

By the construction of a ditch commencing at a point 600 feet south and thirteen feet east of the northeast corner of the South east quarter of the Northwest quarter of section 7, township 19 north Range 5 ~~and Hamilton County~~ running thence N 71° E - 175 feet, thence N 62½° E - 125 feet, thence N 73½° E - 300 feet, thence east, 400 feet, thence S 34° E 135, thence S 54° E 553, thence S 43° E 200 feet, thence S 22° E - 292 feet, thence S 45° E - 95 feet, thence N 84° E 490 feet, thence N 64° E - 60 ft, thence N 45° E - 225 ft, thence N 3° E 175 ft, thence S 18½° W 250 feet, thence N 14° E 100 ft, thence N 25° E 200 ft, thence S 33° E 150 feet, thence N 68½° E 125 feet, thence N 42° E 675 feet, and terminating at a point 661 feet west and 163 feet north of the northeast corner of the South half of the Northwest quarter of section 8 same township and range above named.

Also the Arm. Beginning at a point 200 feet west and 90 feet north of the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section Seven (7) Twp 19 North Range five (5) east, and running thence S 51° W 460 feet, thence S 3° E 1215 feet and terminating on Main Ditch at stake 7487 on said Main Ditch.

Main Ditch to consist of one row of 12 inch tile from 0 to 7487 and one row of 15 inch tile from stake 7487 to stake 4445, and a stone wall at station 4445 and an open ditch from 4445 to 4675.

Arm to consist of one row of 5 inch tile from stake 0 to stake 4460 and one row of 10 inch from 4460 to 6775 or terminus.

#### GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS AND SUGGESTIONS.

The length of the ditch as located is

4670 feet.

The fall of the established grade is

2½/100 feet, from Station 0 to Station 6 to each 100 feet.

1¾/100 " " 6 " 4445 " " "

2½/100 " " 4445 " 4675 " " "

and a drop in grade of 36/100 at 4675

The total fall is 7¾/100 feet to the entire ditch.

The length of the Arm as located is 675 feet and the fall of the established grade for arm is 1¼/100 feet to each 100 feet from 0 to terminus.

All tile used must be first class in every respect and laid in ditch in a true line at the proper grade, and must be left uncovered until inspected by the Surveyor or engineer in charge, after being inspected and accepted by the Surveyor. The trench of ditch to be filled to a depth of not less than 34 inches over the top of tile. The open portion of said ditch to be cut 18 inches wide in bottom with side slopes 1 to 1 or 45° and must be cut true to grade with side slopes trimmed smooth and true to the line of ditch.

There shall be a stone retaining wall 2x5x16 built at station 4445 laid upon mortar made from 1 part portland cement to 3 parts good sharp sand, and so constructed as to receive the tile 18 inches above the base of the wall at the proper grade.

All timber to be deadened for a distance of one rod on each side of ditch and bushes and briars to be grubbed for a distance of 10 feet on each side of ditch.





