

Attached are as-builts, certificate of completion & compliance, and other information for Parkwood Crossing Reconstruction. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes were made to the drain which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain dated April 10, 1989. The changes are as follows:

The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now 6.641 feet. The vacation of the 96th Street drain totaled 2667'ft. The length of open ditch vacated was 1600'ft. This provides a net drain length of 2374' feet.

Non-enforcements were not issued for this area at the time of construction. As buildings are constructed non-enforcements will be submitted for each site.

The bond or letter of credit from Amwest Surety Insurance Co., number # 1183357 and #1176200; in the amount of \$41,500.00 and \$69,000.00; was recommended for release in a letter to the Commissioners dated February 6, 1991.

I recommend the Board approve the drains construction as complete and acceptable.
