The report of the viewers was favorable and was filed. Report of R. D. Horney, County Surveyor, who was appointed to supervise the construction of above drain, would respectfully report that he has made a survey of the above drain and did proceed and definitely determine the best and cheapest method of drainage, the terminal and route, location character of the proposed work, and fix the same by notes and bounds, courses and distances and descriptions, including grades and bench marks, including all necessary arms, estimated the cost thereof, divide the drain or ditch into sections of not more than one hundred feet in length, and computed and set out the number of cubic yards of excavation in each section assessed the benefits or damages as the case may be, to each separate tract of land in the water shed to be affected thereby, and to easements held by railways or other public or private corporations, or towns, including any land rights, easements, or water power, injuriously or beneficially affected, and do make report to the court under oath.

LOCATION. Begin approximate 100 feet north and 200 feet west of the northeast corner of the south half of the northeast quarter of the section 29, township 19, range 3 east.

Follow tile in place to a point 841 feet west and 16 feet south of the northeast corner of northwest quarter of section 33, township 19, range 3 east. Thence follow old open ditch south and southeasterly crossing the center line of section 33, approximately 1400 feet south of the north line of said section; at station 77+10 thence southeasterly to station 87+56 terminating in Eagle Creek.

Said ditch is $\frac{1}{2}$ miles north of Eagletown, Washington township, Hamilton County, Indiana.

REQUIREMENTS. Examine the tile ditch and repair where required and take up and reconstruct 150 lin. feet of 14" tile at end using 40 feet of Vitrified or equal across highway and connect to old ditch. Construct headwall on south side of road at Station 56+ 10 where open ditch begins, as per plans.

All tile to be laid true to grade and tight joints, to be bedded and must be inspected by engineer or authorized assistant before being covered up.

OPEN PORTION

Construct Open ditch from Station 56+10 to Station 87+56 three feet wide in bottom, bank slope $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 1. All dirt to be deposited and spread to at least 2 feet deep and leveled so as it can readily be cultivated over. Where old ditch is near the dirt shall be deposited in old ditch.

All work to be done in a neat and workman like manner and all brush and rubbish shall be cleaned up and deposited at some point nearby.

The contractor shall take care of all fences and must leave them in as good repair as when found.

CLEARING AND GRUBBING

Clear all shrubs and trees along open drain, 50 feet on each side. The Engineer has the right to order any trees left in place if so desired.

All shrubs shall be burned, removed or disposed of and not covered up with dirt.



Re: John Stewart Drain

On July 2, 1979 the Hamilton County Drainage Board awarded a contract to Taylor Excavating for work on the John Stewart Drain. This work consists of placing a structure at the tile outlet, dredging portions of the open drain, digging a 100' sediment trap and clearing all trees smaller than 8". Trees which have been cleared will be piled for the owners to dispose of.

The starting date for the project is October 1, 1979 and the completion date is December 31, 1979. If the crops along the open drain can be harvested as soon as possible before or after the starting date crop damage can be avoided.
