

RE: Masthead Drain Section 10

Attached is a petition, Non-enforcement request, plans, calculations, Quantity summary and assessment roll for the Masthead Drain, Section 10. I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health, benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefitted. The drain will consist of the following:


12" RCP	35 L.F.
15" RCP	543 L.F.
18" RCP	250 L.F.
6" SSD	170 L.F.
Swales/open ditch	500 L.F.

The total length of the drain will be 1498 feet.

I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$20.00 per lot or Block with \$2.00 per acre for roadways. With this assessment the total annual assessment for this section (section 10) will be \$526.58

At this time the system is complete except for the 6" SSD. Shorewood has submitted a check to the County Auditor to cover the expense of completing the system. This will be returned upon completion.

I recommend a hearing be set for February 1985 meeting.

In the matter of Masthead Subdivision, Sections
Ten Drain Petition.

Petitioner ~~is~~ the owner of all lots in the land affected by the proposed new legal drain. The drainage will affect various lots in Masthead-Section Ten, a subdivision in Hamilton County, Indiana. The general route of such drainage shall be in existing easements and along public roads as shown in the plans on file in the Surveyor's Office.

Petitioner believes that the cost, damages and expenses of the proposed improvement will be less than the benefits which will result to the owners of the land likely to be benefited thereby. Petitioner believes the proposed improvement will:

- (a) improve public health
- (b) benefit a public street
- (c) be of public utility

Petitioner agrees to pay the cost of construction of the storm sewers and requests periodic maintenance assessments by the Board thereafter. The Petitioner also agrees to the following:

1. To provide the Drainage Board a performance bond for the portion of the storm sewer system which will be made a legal drain. The bond will be in the amount of 100% of the Engineers estimate. Bond will be in effect until construction of 100% of the system is completed and so certified by the Engineer.
2. The Developer shall retain the Engineer throughout the construction phase. At completion of the project the Developers Engineer shall certify that the storm sewer system which is to be maintained as a legal drain has been constructed as per construction plans.
3. Any changes made in the field shall be documented and given to the Surveyor to be placed the the Drain file.
4. The developer shall instruct his Engineer to provide a reproducible print on a 24" x 36" mylar of the final design of the Drainage System.

The Petitioner further requests that the Drain be classified as an Urban Drain.




RE: Masthead Drain, Section 10

Attached is a engineers Certificate of Completion and compliance and as built development plan for the drainage facilities for Masthead, Section 10. In October 1985, I made a final inspection of the drain and found the system to be complete and acceptable.

Two (2) modifications were made on this section, both dealing with open channels. Approximately 180 feet of swale was added to the regulated drainage system along the South side of Fall Creek Road, between structures 404 and 407. Also, 250 feet of open channel was included with this section instead of Section 11, along the South line of Lots 312,313 and 314. The Board should also note that the only S.S.D. being taken into the regulated drain system is the G.S.S.D for Lots 307,308 and 309. With the modifications listed above, the total length for this section should be revised from the original length given in my report dated December 26, 1984 to 1,928 feet.

Also, attached is a nonenforcement request for this section which should be approved.
