Re: U.G. Mitchner Drain, Setters Run #293 Arm

Upon review of the U.G. Mitchner Drain watershed area, I believe that the Setters Run Drain should be made an arm to the U.G. Mitchner Drain, as the Setters Run Drain discharges to the U.G. Mitchner Drain. This would eliminate the double maintenance assessment on these tracts currently assessed for both the Setters Run Drain and the U.G. Mitchner Drain.

The Setters Run Drain was created per my report dated April 18, 1996 and approved by the Board at a hearing on July 22, 1996 (See Drainage Board Minute Book #4, pages 266 to 267). At present the Setters Run Drain maintenance assessment affects 51.59 acres and 177 lots. The rates of assessment for the drain are set at \$5.00 per acre with a \$15.00 minimum. This rate collects \$3,081.36 annually and the balance within the fund is \$7,159.95. There are no outstanding work orders for this drain at this time.

The following maintenance assessments shall be set for the U.G. Mitchner Drain:

1. Maintenance assessment for platted lots within subdivisions whose drainage system will be part of the regulated drain shall be set at \$65.00 per lot/minimum. Common areas within the regulated drain subdivisions shall be set at \$10.00 per acre with a \$65.00 minimum.

The total annual assessment for this arm will be \$12,847.70.

The current balance of the Setters Run Drain shall be kept separate and these funds expended for needed maintenance on the Setters Run Drain. This shall be done until the funds are exhausted. At that time funding for repairs shall then be taken from the U.G. Mitchner Drain maintenance fund.

Future assessments for the drainage area of the Setters Run Drain will be made into the U.G. Mitchner Drain maintenance fund. No further maintenance collections for the Setters Run Drain shall be made after 2013 other than any delinquent assessment penalties and interest which remain unpaid.

I recommend that the Board set a hearing for this consolidation for June 24, 2013.

In regards to the proposed annual assessment increase, we would like to object to the increase of our charge from the current \$10 to the proposed \$65 (a 550% increase)

The copy of the surveyor's report shows that our property is part of the U.G. Mitchner Drain Setters Run #293 Arm. The notice and report does not provide information on what is causing the need for the annual assessment of the drain to increase from \$50,284 to \$83,234 (a 66% increase) and the Arm portion to increase from \$3,081.36 to \$12,847 (a 317% increase). Our suspicion is that it is due to the increased development by Bridgewater surrounding the Setters Run edition. At this point in time, much of the land is not designated as lots and suspect that the increased drainage and retention ponds in the new developments are causing the lots to receive a significantly higher charge. Specifically, we object to the Setters Run #293 Arm having to bear the same proportion of the increase as the lots directly in the U.G. Mitchner Drain area due to the cause of the needed increase. Without a reason given for the disproportionate increase (550% increase for our assessment) or listing of benefits received, we object to assessment increase.



At it's meeting on June 24th the Hamilton County Drainage Board considered your objection to on the above referenced hearing. At that meeting the Board approved the combination and rate increase. The total objections filed against the proposal amounted to 1.02% of the drainage shed.

Please be aware that the decrease in assessment time was but a minor part of the proposal. With the computer program the county utilizes for this additional work is negligible. The main reason for the combination is to benefit the property owners in Setters Run. If the combination did not occur the property owners in Setters Run would be paying an additional \$65.00 annually because they would be double assessed. The \$65.00 rate is the standard rate in Hamilton County for lots within subdivisions in which the drainage facilities within the subdivision are part of the regulated drain system.



Notice of Hearing to Establish Annual Assessments for the Periodic Maintenance of the **U.G. Mitchner**, **Setters Run Arm**.

Under the Indiana Drainage Code, all land which drains directly, or indirectly, may be assessed for either maintenance cost or reconstruction cost within the drain. In making the calculation for each parcel, the Drainage Board must calculate the percentage of the cost attributable to each parcel of land benefitted. From time to time the assessments may be increased or changed. The chart below contains your proposed assessment and your percentage of the total annual maintenance contribution to the costs attributable to providing drainage to your land.

The Drainage Board has received a maintenance report and schedule of assessments which affects your land. You are hereby notified that the maintenance report of the County Surveyor and the schedule of assessments made by the Drainage Board have been filed and are available for public inspection in the office of the County Surveyor.

The Surveyor has estimated that the annual cost of periodically maintaining the entire drain is \$12,847.70. The schedule of assessments shows you are the owner of tracts within the drainage shed. The following is your pro rata share for each tract and the proposed annual assessment for those tracts: This assessment is not a charge for services associated with regulating the quality of storm water within your city or town.

A public hearing will be held by the Drainage Board in Commissioner's Court at 9:05 A.M. on June 24, 2013 on the Surveyor's maintenance report and the proposed schedule of assessments. The law requires that any objection must be written and filed not less than five (5) days before the above hearing on the ground that benefits assessed are excessive. Written evidence in support of objections may also be filed. The failure of any owner to file an objection constitutes a waiver of his right to thereafter object on such ground to any final action of the Board. On or before the hearing date the Surveyor or any owner of lands named in the schedule of assessments may cause written evidence to be filed in support of or in rebuttal to any objection filed.
