Re: Morrow-Follett Drain, 2nd Street NW Arm

At the Drainage Board hearing on April 25, 2016 (Hamilton County Drainage Board Minutes Book 16 pages 524-527), for the partial vacation of the J.W. Morrow Arm of the Morrow-Follett Drain, the motion was contingent on picking up the drainage in the street that Carmel has previously reconstructed. This is a hearing to add the pipe in 2nd Street NW and provide continuous regulated drain for the remaining portion of J.W. Morrow Arm from Sta. 25+22 to Sta. 27+27.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in this report. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable, will improve the public health, benefit a public highway, and be of public utility and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

15" RCP 246 ft.

The total length of the drain to be added to the Morrow-Follett Drain will be 246 feet.

The footage listed above is from the curb inlet on the north side of 2nd Street NW, which is where the Morrow-Follett Drain, JW Morrow Arm, terminates at Sta. 27+27. The drain then runs directly west and connects to the Morrow-Follett Drain, City of Carmel Reconstruction Arm at Str. 18, at the west side of 2nd Avenue NW.

Since the drain is maintained by the City of Carmel per agreement of the Board on June 5, 1995 (HCDB Minutes Book 4, Page 125), the parcels in this area will not be assessed at this time.

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

I recommend that upon approval of the above proposed drain that the easements be set to the existing north and south right-of-way lines on 2nd Street NW, which is all owned by the City of Carmel.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposed drain for July 25, 2016.

FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the Morrow-Follett Drain, 2nd Street NW Arm came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing on July 25, 2016, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the Morrow-Follett Drain, 2^{nd} Street NW Arm be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:


