Re: Morrow-Follett Drain, Village Green Townhomes Reconstruction

Attached is a petition and plans for the proposed relocation of the Morrow-Follett Drain. The relocation is being proposed by Drees Homes. The proposal is to (relocate and reconstruct) the drain from Structure #21 of the 1990 City of Carmel Reconstruction (Surveyor's Report dated June 5, 1995 and approved by the Board on June 5, 1995, Drainage Board Minutes Book 4, Page 125) to Station 47+88 of the 1906 legal description. This is shown on Sheet C104 of Village Green Townhomes Section 2 plans by Weihe Engineering, last revision date of June 25, 2007 and project number W06-0862.

The line will consist of the following:

72" RCP 34 ft. 4' x 12' Concrete Box 181 ft.

Open Ditch 557 ft.

The reconstructed drain begins at existing Structure #21 and is 34' of 72" RCP to Structure 731 per the Weihe plans. Then 157 feet of open ditch through the pond in Common Area "D" to Structure 724; 181' of 4' x 12' concrete box from Structure 724 to Structure 728. The drain then continues northerly as open ditch for approximately 400 feet. This point is the confluence of Little Cool Creek and is also Station 47+88 of the original drain.

The total length of new drain shall be 772 feet. The 742 feet of original drain between Sta. 40+46, (which is also Structure #21) and Sta.47+88 shall be vacated. This proposal will add an additional 30 feet to the drains total length.

The cost of the relocation is to be paid by Drees Homes. Because the project is to be paid by the petitioner and is within the boundaries of the petitioners property the project fall under the requirements as set out in IC 36-9-27-52.5. Therefore, a public hearing with 30 day notice is not required for the petition.

The petitioner has provided the performance bond as follows:

I recommend that upon approval of the above proposed drain that the Board also approve the attached non-enforcement request. CITY OF CARMEL WATER AND SEWER UNDER PAVEMENT, SIDEWALK, PAVED AREAS AND WITHIN RIGHT-OF-WAY

BEDDING, HAUNCHING, INITIAL BACKFILL
Bedding, Haunching and initial backfill requirements and compaction for water
mains, water service laterals, sanitary mains and sanitary service laterals shall be
in accordance with the standard practice of the utility that has jurisdiction over
the installation.

FINAL BACKFILL
Final backfill for water mains, water service laterals, sanitary mains and sanitary service laterals under and within 5—feet of pavement or sidewalk or other paved areas and for all installations within City right—of—way shall be B—Borrow for Structure Backfill meeting the material requirements of the INDOT. The material shall be approved by the City of Carmel Department of Engineering at time of installation. Final backfill shall be compacted in 6—inch maximum lifts to not less than 95% Standard Proctor Density for the entire depth of the material placed. The backfill for the top 6—inches of the excavation below the start of the aggregate sub—base of the pavement shall be No. 53 Stone meeting the material requirement of the INDOT and shall be compacted to not less than 95% Standard Proctor Density. If the standard practice of the utility that has jurisdiction over the installation has a more stringent backfill requirement, the more stringent requirement shall govern.

MINIMUM COVER FOR PIPE CROSSINGS WITHIN CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY

For installation of Storm Mains, Water Mains, Sanitary Mains, Water Service Laterals, Sanitary Service Laterals under City streets, regardless of jurisdiction of the utility, the minimum cover from the top of the installed pavement to the top of the installed pipe shall be the pavement section thickness (all bituminous and aggregate material above the subgrade) plus 1-0", but under no circumstances shall the cover along any part of the pipe from the final pavement elevation to the top of the pipe be less than 2.5-feet. If the standard practice of the utility that has jurisdiction over the installation has a more stringent cover requirement, the more stringent requirement shall govern.

Cover heights for reinforced concrete pipe storm sewer that are less than those required will be evaluated on a case by case condition and approved only with written permission by the city engineer.
