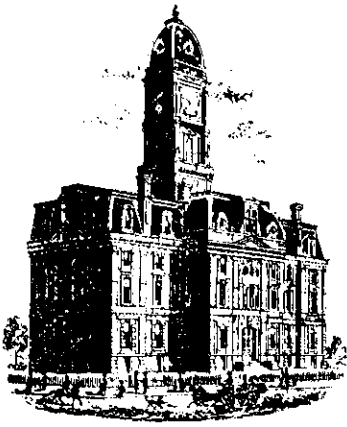

Re: Margaret O'Brien Drain, Crosspointe Arm

Attached is a petition, non-enforcement and plans for the proposed relocation of the Margaret O'Brien Drain. The relocation is being proposed by Erie Indianapolis Florida, LLC (Erie). The proposal is to relocate a portion of the temporary open ditch which was constructed with the original Crosspointe Development. This temporary ditch will be filled and relocated across the Erie property with a new 48" RCP along the east property line along Crosspointe Blvd. And a temporary open ditch along the north property line.

The line will consist of the following:

48" RCP 818 ft


The total length of new storm sewer shall be 818 feet. The 790 feet of original temporary drain between the existing outlet of 48" RCP north of Centerpoint Drain and the north line of the Erie property shall be vacated. This proposal will add an additional 28 feet to the drains total length.

The cost of the relocation is to be paid by Erie Indianapolis Florida, LLC. Because the project is to be paid by the petitioner and is within the boundaries of the petitioners property the project falls under the requirements as set out in IC 36-9-27-52.5. Therefore, a hearing is not required for the petition.

The petitioner has provided the performance bond as follows:

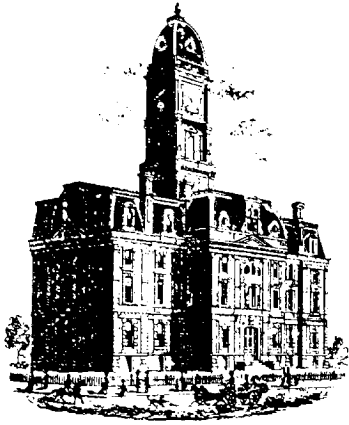

Attached are as-builts, certificate of completion & compliance, and other information for Eric Arm to the Margaret Obrien Drain. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes there were no significant changes made to the drainage plans submitted with my report for this drain dated May 14, 2001. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 6, Page 43) Therefore, the length of the drain remains at **818 feet**. It also should be noted that the drain removed was temporary and had not been included in the Margaret O'brien drain length.

The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on June 25, 2001 and recorded under instrument #200100047455.

The following sureties were guaranteed by First Union National Bank and released by the Board on its January 14, 2008 meeting.
