Come the petitioners and so to the satisfaction of the Court that the Report of the Drainage commissioners hereto filed on the 2^d day of Nov. 1891. and that more than ten days have elapsed exclusive of Sundays, since the filing of the same, and there being no remonstrance filed, the Court now find that the report of Drainage commissioners herein should be confirmed, and the assessments made thereby be approved.

It is therefore considered and ordered by the Court that the Report of the Drainage commissioners made herein to-wit:

Report of Commissioners
To the Honorable Judge of the Hamilton Circuit Court:

The undersigned, Commissioners of Drainage to whom was referred the petition of Peter Paulsel Et. al. For the drainage of SW. ¼ NW. ¼ NW. ¼ Sec 13 Town 18 R. 4 East. The NE ¼ NW ¼ of SE ¼ 10 Acres off North side of S ½ SE ¼ Sec 14 Town 18 R 4 East and 23 Acres off South side SE ¼ Sec 14 Town 18 R 4 East NE ¼ NW ¼ Sec 23 Town 18 R 4 East; NW ¼ SW ¼ S.E. ¼ of NW ¼ Sec 23. Town 18 R 4 East 2 in Hamilton County, respectfully report that they have inspected personally all the lands described in said petition, and all other lands described in said petition, and all other lands liable to be affected by the construction of the proposed work; and are of the opinion that the proposed drainage will be of Public Utility a Benefit to the Health of the Neighborhood and will Benefit two Public

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Highways and that the costs of the same will be less than the aggregate Benefits, and after making the necessary surveys and Examinations are of the opinion that the method of Drainage.

They estimate the cost of constructing the work at \$799.55 dollars.

They further report that they have estimated the benefits and injury to the several tracts of land which will be affected by the work, as follows:

By the construction of a Ditch commencing about 60 rods East 40 rods South of NW Cor of NW 1/4 Sec 23 Town 18 R 4 East running Thence North 20° East 500 Thence N 30° East 500 Thence N 38° East 1240 Thence N 38° East 2235 Thence N 43° East 725 Thence East 18° South 400 Thence East 900 feet Terminating in a ravine about 20 rods North and 18 East of S.W. Cor NW 1/4 Sec 13 Town 18 R 4 East.

Said Ditch to be Filled with one row of 7 inch tile from station 0 To station 10 from station 10 To station 23 One row of 7 & One row of 8 inch tile from station 23 To terminous One row of 7 and one row of 10 inch tile.

Manner of Construction

All tile to be good sound merchantable tile free from cracks and end splits and of good color and to be laid on a uniform grade well matched together, no tile to be covered until after inspection after which the ditch is to be filled up. From Stake 0 to Stake 46 the old tile to be taken up, cleaned and relaid in new channel. All Broken tile to be repaired with new ones of same size all excavation made in resurfacing the old tile to be filled up.

All work to be done in a good and workmanlike manner and to the entire satisfaction of the Superintendent in charge of construction.
