Horney, County Surveyor, who was appointed to supervise the construction of above drain, would respectfully report that he has made a survey of the above drain and did proceed and definitely determine the best and cheapest method of drainage, the terminal and route, location, character of the proposed work, and fix the same by metes and bounds, courses and distances and descriptions, including grades and bench marks including all necessary arms, estimated the cost thereof, divided the drain or ditch into sections of not more than one hundred feet in length, and computed and set out the number of cubic yards of excavation in each section, assessed the benefits of damages as the case may be, to each separate tract of land in the water shed to be affected thereby and to easements held by railways or other public or private corporations, or towns, including any land rights, easements, or water power, injuriously or beneficially affected, and do make report to the court under oath.

LOCATION In Washington Township approximately one-half mile north of Horton and 40 rods west at Monon R. R. Tracks - Begin at a point 47 rods east of the northwest corner of the west half of Northeast Quarter, Section 16, Township 19 North, Range 3 East, thence in a easterly and southeasterly course terminating in open drain approximately 400 feet south and 75.0 feet East of the Northwest corner of Southeast Quarter Section 14, Township 19 North, Range 3 East.

REQUIREMENTS From Station 45 + 62 clean out mud, slush, boulders, shrubbery and debris to Station 55 + 0 out of bottom and slopes of ditch.

All shrubs on slopes and 5.0 feet from break of bank to be cut off flush with ground. In bottom they must be pulled out. All dirt to be deposited not nearer than 5.0 feet from break of slope, and shall be leveled so can be cultivated over.

Near the Southwest corner of ditch and East R/W of Monon R. R. a clump of willows are to be pulled and piled and burned.

All shrubs and clearing to be piled and burned.

From Station 55 + 0. The viewers have examined the ground and recommend that the ditch be extended in a easterly and southeasterly direction following along and near the old channel of branch to Station 70 + 50 by a new

channel terminating approximately 400 feet South and 75.0 feet East of the Northwest corner of Southeast Quarter, Section 14, Township 19 North, Range 3 East in branch.

The ditch to be slope 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 - 3' - 0 bottom.

The dirt in new cuts to be deposited in old channel or near so can be leveled in old channel.

All shrubs and clearing to be piled and burned and not covered with dirt unless authorized by the engineer.

The contractor shall move all fences and replace same, but not furnish any new material.

Clean out from under County Highway Bridge and other culverts and pipe on ditch.

The assessments will be due and payable when work is started. The assessments are on an acreage basis.

The contractor not to receive more than 70% of work completed as work progresses. The contractor to receive payment only when assessments are paid in. The work to be completed in 40 days from time contract is awarded unless authorized otherwise by the Engineer.

All work to be done in a neat and workmanlike manner and expedited as rapidly as practical after work is started.

Work to be done by drag line machine.

Ditch.

To the Honorable Board of Commissioners of

Hamilton

County, Indiana:

We, the undersigned, appointed by this Court, at its Regular April Term, 1900, to view a drain described in the certified copy of a petition and order of Court for a Public Drain, by *Henry Pless* and others, handed us by the Auditor, would represent that according to said order we, on the day named therein, to wit: The 17th day of April, 1900, in company with *J. A. Mitchell*, a civil engineer, made an accurate survey of the line of said proposed Drain, from its source to its outlet. A plat of said Ditch is filed herewith, including the survey by the engineer, marked "Exhibit B." We caused stakes to be set along said line, each one hundred feet, numbering down stream, as shown by plat. We also made a computation of the total number of cubic yards of earth to be removed from said drain, and estimated the total cost for the construction of the work at \$997.24 Dollars.

We also apportioned and set apart to each parcel of land a share of said work in proportion to the benefits received, all of which will fully appear by a tabular statement in this report. We have also set out, by a statement below, the names of the owners of lands benefited, with a description of each tract of land, and the amount assessed against each tract. The depth of cut, the width at bottom, and width at top along said drain, is also shown in a tabular statement in this report. After a full and careful view and examination, we are of the opinion that the drain, as located by the survey, will be of public utility, and that the cost of the construction of the same will be less than the benefits to be derived therefrom; and that the proposed drainage can best be accomplished by a tile drain from Stake 0 to Stake 45+62 feet, and from Stake 45+62 ft. to Stake 55 to be an open drain. From Stake 0 to Stake 15 the ditch shall consist of one row of 12 inch tile, and from Stake 15 to Stake 26 shall consist of one row of 16 inch tile; from Stake 26 to Stake 45+46 feet shall consist of one row of 18 inch tile, and from 45+46 to 45+62 shall be 20 inch saltglazed sewer tile; and from 45+62 to Stake 55 shall be an open ditch 18 inches wide in bottom, side sloped 45°.

The drain known as the Henry Prew Ditch is located as follows: beginning at a point 47 rods east and 168 feet north of the northwest corner of the west half of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15 Township 19 North Range 3 east and running hence south from Stake 0 to Stake 8+15 = 815 feet hence south 44° east from 8+15 to 15+17 = 702 feet, hence south 89° east from Stake 15+17 to Stake 16+83 = 166 feet, hence south 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° east from Stake 24+25 to 26+25 = 200 feet, hence south 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° east from Stake 26+25 to 29+33 = 308 feet, hence south 30° east from Stake 29+33 to 32+65 = 332 feet hence south 16 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° east from Stake 32+65 to 36+80 = 418 feet, hence south 42° east from Stake 36+80 to 38+85 = 205 feet, hence south 84° east from Stake 38+85 to 40+42 = 157 feet hence 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° east from 40+42 to 45+80 = 538 feet, hence south 83 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° east from Stake 45+80 to 53 = 720 feet, hence east from Stake 53 to 53 = 200 feet.

Requirements

All work done must be accepted by County Surveyor, and all tile used must be of the best quality. The tile to be laid in ditch and inspected and accepted before being covered. The covering shall be so as to admit of cultivation over line of ditch and shall be to the satisfaction of County Surveyor. The stone wall shall be 10 ft x 6 ft x 2 ft and to be made from field rocks or riverheads laid up in mortar made from 3 parts sand to one part portland cement of standard brand; tile to be embedded in well air proper grade and thoroughly sluiced. Base of wall to be 16 inches below grade line of tile.
