

Re: Harriet Sheward Drain

After the Sheward Drain was placed on maintenance last May a survey was made for a new headwall at the outlet. After the survey was completed a rock chute structure was designed for the outlet. During the design process it was found that the open ditch should be dredged to a point 900' down stream from the outlet. The cost estimate for this work is \$6270.00.

The Drainage Board has determined that this work should be done as a reconstruction rather than under maintenance. The cost shown on the enclosed notice is determined on the basis of \$17 benefit to each acre in the drainage shed. Please note that the maintenance assessment will be a separate assessment which is not shown on the enclosed notice.

NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the Hamilton County Drainage Board at its regular meeting January 7, 1980 adopted the reconstruction report of the Surveyor and the Amended schedule of damages and assessments including annual assessment for periodic maintenance, finding that the costs, damages and expense of the proposed improvement would be less than the benefits which will result to the owner of lands benefited thereby.

The Board issued an order declaring the proposed improvement established. Such findings and order were marked filed and are available for inspection in the Office of the Hamilton County Surveyor.

If judicial review of the findings and order of the Board is not requested pursuant to Article VIII of the 1965 Indiana Drainage Code as amended within twenty (20) days from the date of publication of this notice, the findings and order shall become conclusive.
