

Re: Oliver Shoemaker Drain

Attached is a petition and plans for the proposed relocation of the Oliver Shoemaker Drain. The relocation is being proposed by C. P. Morgan Communities, LP. The proposal is to relocate portions of Arm 2 through Woodberry Section 5.

The line will consist of the following:

15" RCP 83 ft 24" RCP 193 ft 27" RCP 134 ft

The tile portion of Arm 2 is that which is located between structures 218, 219, 220, 221 and 299. This system lies between Lots 116 and 117; 110 and 111; and along the east side of lot 111 and 112.

The total length of new tile shall be 410 feet. The 180 feet of original drain between Sta. 18+30 and Sta. 16+50 of Arm 2 shall be vacated. This proposal will add an additional 230 feet to the drains total length.

The cost of the relocation is to be paid by C. P. Morgan. Because the project is to be paid by the petitioner and is within the boundaries of the petitioners property the project falls under the requirements as set out in IC 36-9-27-52.5. Therefore, a hearing is not required for the petition.



Attached are as-builts, certificate of completion & compliance, and other information for Oliver Shoemaker Drain: Woodberry 5 Relocation. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes were made to the drain, which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain-dated January 24, 2001. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held February 26, 2001. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 5, Pages 570-571) The changes are as follows:

The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now 409 feet. Arm 2 of the drain was vacated from Sta 18+30 to 16+50. There was a section of Arm 2 not mentioned in the report for Woodberry Sec 4 this was the vacation of Sta 22+50 to 21+20. Therefore, there was a net gain of 99 feet.

The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on February 26, 2001 and recorded under instrument #2001\_00029745.

The bond or letter of credit from Gulf Insurance, number BE0939961; dated November 2, 2000; in the amount of \$29,785; was released.

I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.
