Attached is a petition, non-enforcement request, as built plans, calculations, assessment roll, and certificate of completion and compliance for the Springmill Streams Section 9 Arm of the Springmill Streams Drain.

I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be off public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accuruing to the owners of land likely to be benefitted. The drain will consist of the following:

6" SSD	550 ft	18" RCP	471 £t
12" RCP	96 f t	21" RCP	450 ft
15" RCP	351. ft.	8"CMP	20 ft

The total length of the drain will be 1938 Feet.

The SSD, which will be included as part of the regulated drain, are those along the north line of Lot 218, and Lots 211 and 212 to STR 665. The SSD along the south line of Lots 207, 208, and 209, which is part of the regulated drain, was installed with Section 6. The SSD installed along the curb is not included as part of the regulated drain.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally.

I recommend a maintenance assessment of $$20^{00}$ per lot, $$2^{00}$ per acre for roadways, with a $$20^{00}$ minimum. With this assessment, the total annual assessment for the drain/this section will be

At this time, the drain has been completed except for the lines between STR's 678 and 679 and 671 and 672. These portions cannot be constructed until easements or right of way is obtained along the west side of Clay Center Road; so that STR 672 and 679 along with the road side drainage can be installed. The lengths for these sections are included with the above lengths. The 12" CMP under Clay Center Road on the west side of Lot 216 is not part of the regulated drain. The open ditch is not included, but is part of the Stultz-Almond regulated drain.

I recommend a hearing be set for February 1990. I recommend the Board approve the attached non-enforcement request at the hearing, if the petition is approved.


