RE: **Barrington Estates Drain, Sturgill Relocation**

Attached is a petition and plans for the proposed relocation of the 6" SSD drain. The relocation is being proposed by Joe & Jennifer Sturgill. The proposal is to relocate and reconstruct the 6" SSD across Lot 25 in Barrington Estates Sec. 2.

The relocation will consist of the following:

Two small 2' x 2' storm structures set on the end east of the proposed swimming pool on the petitioner's property and new 6" Hi-Q double-wall SSD re-routed around the pool deck to the area of the existing SSD on Lot 25. The new SSD will tie into the existing drain approximately 18' west of the east property line. The new drain will be a minimum of 5' off of the proposed north edge of the 4' deck and 10' off of the proposed east edge of the deck.

The re-routed drain will remain within the existing platted drainage easement.

The total length of new drain shall be 88 feet. The 72 feet of original drain in the proposed footprint of the new pool shall be vacated. This proposal will add an additional 16 feet to the drain total length.

The cost of the relocation is to be paid by Joe & Jennifer Sturgill. Because the project is to be paid by the petitioner and is within the boundaries of the petitioners property the project fall under the requirements as set out in IC 36-9-27-52.5. Therefore, a public hearing with 30 day notice is not required for the petition.

The non-enforcement allowing the proposed pool encroachment was approved at the March 28, 2016 drainage board meeting. The approved non-enforcement will be recorded upon the completion of the 52.5 hearing.



PETITION FOR RELOCATION AND RECONSTRUCTION

Joe & Jennifer Sturgill (hereinafter "Petitioner"),

1. Petitioner owns real estate through which a portion of the 6" Storm Sewer Drain runs.
