RE: Village of West Clay Drain – Section 3004 #2

Attached is a petition and plans for the proposed relocation of the Village of West Clay Drain, Section 3004 Arm. The relocation is being proposed by the City of Carmel. The proposal is to reconfigure the parking spaces along Broad Street, which will change storm structures on the Village of West Clay Drain, Section 3004 Arm and add new footage to the drain arm.

The relocated drain shall consist of those lengths of pipes between the following structures as shown on sheet C102 of the plans for the Village of West Clay - Copeland Building prepared by Schneider Engineering, dated January 2, 2007, and having job number 1238.063: the existing castings on Str. B652 and B653 of the original Section 3004 Arm will be replaced with a solid manhole castings.

The additional new drain shall be the length of pipe between the following structures: B653 of the original Section 3004 Arm to Str. B652.1 and B653 of the original Section 3004 Arm to Str. B653.1 on the current plans.

The drain in total will consist of the following lengths: 12" RCP -36 ft

The total length of new tile shall be 36 feet. This proposal will add an additional 36 feet to the Village of West Clay Drain – Section 3004 Arm.

The cost of the relocation is to be paid by the Brenwick Development. Because the project is to be paid by Brenwick and is within the boundaries of the public Right of Way of the City of Carmel, who petitioned for the reconstruction, the project falls under the requirements as set out in IC 36-9-27-52.5. Therefore, a noticed hearing is not required for the petition.

The petitioner was not required to provide a performance bond since this is a City of Carmel project.

The easement for this new drain being added to the Village of West Clay Drain, Section 3004 Arm shall be the new proposed Right of Way line for Broad Street as dedicated to the City of Carmel by the Dedication & Deed of Public Rights-of-Way, recorded as instrument 200700027941 in the Office of the Hamilton County Recorder.

I recommend approval by the Board at this time.



reconstruction of a portion of the Village of WestClay Drain, as

the sole expense of the Petitioner and such work will result in substantial improvement to	
the Village of WestClay Drain, without cost to other property owners	
on the watershed of the Village of WestClay Drain.	
5. Proposed relocation and reconstruction will not adversely affect other land owners within	
the drainage shed.	
6. Petitioner requests approval of the proposed relocation and reconstruction under	
IC 36-9-27-52.5.

Attached are as-builts, certificate of completion & compliance, and other information for Village of West Clay Section 3004- Copeland Building. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes there were no significant changes made to the drainage plans submitted with my report for this drain dated August 31, 2007. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held September 10, 2007. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 10, Page 395) Therefore, the length of the drain remains at **36 feet**.

The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on May 29, 2007and recorded under instrument #2007029222. Sureties were not posted for this project.

I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.
