Re: Wheeler & Wheeler Drain, Howe Road Arm – Greenfield Ave. & Howe Road Roundabout Reconstruction

Attached are petition and plans for the proposed reconstruction of the Wheeler & Wheeler Drain, Howe Road Arm. This project is to be paid for by the City of Noblesville. The proposal is to reconstruct the existing tile drains currently in the Greenfield Avenue right-of-way and Howe Road right-of-way owned by the City of Noblesville; on parcel 10-11-08-00-00-014.000 owned by Brian M. & Emma M. Edwards; parcel 10-11-08-00-00-012.000, owned by A. Donald Wiles II, Trustee of A. Donald Wiles II Revocable Trust; also affected are parcels 10-11-08-00-00-015.000 owned by Angela L. Cottrell; and parcel 10-11-08-00-15-065.000 owned by Arbor Grove Home Owners Association, Inc., per the Greenfield Avenue & Howe Road Roundabout project plans by Butler, Fairman & Seufert, Inc., Project No. 1401716, filed June 21, 2017.

Per the plans, the upstream and of this extension will begin at an existing manhole (Str. 100) on the west side of Howe Road, approximately 239' feet south of the existing centerline of Greenfield Avenue, which is at Station 0+00 of the existing Howe Road Arm (Sta. 52+42 current plans). A new pipe will drain north and cross under Greenfield Avenue and tie into the existing 12" Howe Road Arm approximately 276' north of the existing centerline of Greenfield Avenue (Sta. 52+76.2 at Str. 33).

This reconstruction will consist of the following:

234' of 18" RCP

139' of 30" RCP

53" of 21" RCP 96" (

96' of 6" SSD

The new drain involves the following structures: 100 (existing), 28, 23, 13, 14, 30, 32, 32-endsection, Underdrain cleanout, and 33.

The newly installed drain will have a length of 522'.

Regarding the existing drain, this project will remove 527' of drain from existing Str. 5 to 247' north of existing Str. 3. This proposal will subtract 5' of footage from the drain's total length.

The 96' of SSD noted above, drains below the dry detention area. The detention area is not to be considered part of the regulated drain for maintenance. Drain maintenance at the dry detention area shall include the SSD, the pipe inlet and outlet as part of the regulated drain. The maintenance of the pond such as sediment removal, erosion control along the banks, mowing and aquatic vegetation control will be the responsibility of the City of Noblesville. The Board will retain jurisdiction for ensuring the storage volume for which the dry pond was designed will be retained, thereby, allowing no fill or easement encroachments. The water quality unit (Str.31) will be maintained by the City of Noblesville. The other storm facilities not listed in this report will be maintained by the City of Noblesville.

The Wheeler & Wheeler Drain, Howe Road Arm was established in 1990. The drain is currently on a maintenance program which was approved at hearing on October 15, 1990. See Minutes Book 2, Pages 455-456 and 472-473.

The cost of the project is to be paid by the City of Noblesville. The petitioner has not submitted surety for the proposed drain reconstruction, as this requirement has been waived for the City.

The new drain will be installed within existing regulated drain easement or in road right-of-way. Therefore, the easement for the new drain shall be the existing easement and the right-of-way for Howe Road and Greenfield Avenue, whichever is greater.

I recommend the Board set a hearing date for August 28, 2017.

On this 28^{th} day of August, 2017, the Hamilton County Drainage Board has held a hearing on the Maintenance Report and Schedule of Assessments of the Wheeler & Wheeler Drain, Howe Road Arm - Greenfield Avenue & Howe Road Roundabout Reconstruction (Existing Structure 5 to 247' north of Existing Structure 3).

Evidence has been heard. Objections were presented and considered. The Board then adopted an order of action. The Board now finds that the costs of continued maintenance to the portion of the above drain exceed the benefits to the real estate benefited by the portion of the drain to be abandoned and issues this order vacating the above section of the Wheeler & Wheeler Drain, Howe Road Arm - Greenfield Avenue & Howe Road Roundabout Reconstruction (Existing Structure 5 to 247' north of Existing Structure 3).

FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the Wheeler & Wheeler Drain, Howe Road Arm - Greenfield Avenue & Howe Road Roundabout Reconstruction came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing on August 28, 2017, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the Wheeler & Wheeler Drain, Howe Road Arm - Greenfield Avenue & Howe Road Roundabout Reconstruction be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:

Attached are as-builts and other information for Greenfield Ave & Howe Rd Roundabout Reconstruction. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.


During construction, changes were made to the drain, which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain-dated July 6, 2017. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held August 28, 2017. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 17, Pages 446-448) The changes are as follows: the project saw the instillation of 316 feet of 12" RCP. The majority of this was installed as the contractor replaced the existing 12" concrete tile from new structure 33 to the outlet of the drain into the existing Wheeler and Wheeler Drain (existing structure 2). The 18" RCP was lengthened from 234 feet to 238 feet. The 21" RCP was lengthened from 53 feet to 68 feet. The 30" RCP was not installed. It was downsized to 79 feet of 24" RCP. The 6" SSD was shortened from 96 feet to 93 feet. The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now 794 feet. It should be noted, the project removed and or replaced the existing drain from Sta. 0 to Sta. 8+05.

The ownership and maintenance for all the BMP's are the responsibility of the City of Noblesville. All work was performed in existing right of way and or regulated drainage easement. This project was paid for by the City of Noblesville.

I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.





