



RE: Wheeler and Wheeler Drain-Howe Road Arm

An inspection of the above referenced drainage facility showed that the arm is now complete and acceptable. This work was done by Sweeney Construction Corporation, under a contract awarded January 22, 1991.

The contract was expanded by one Change Order for twenty-five (25') feet of twelve (12") inch tile at a cost of \$262.50. With a contract cost of \$19,855.00, the total project cost including the Change Order is \$20,117.50. This is under the original construction estimate set out in my report dated August 17, 1990, which was \$25,278.00.

At this time all payments to the Contractor have been made. The first was dated June 7, 1991 for \$16,026.75 and the seconded dated August 9, 1991 for \$4,090.75. The Contractor has submitted the necessary statement concerning labor and material payments.

The Indiana Department of Highway has approved and released the work for road cut, Permit # 91GC00078.

Therefore, I recommend the Board approve the project as complete and acceptable.
