

TO: HAMILTON COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD

RE: Spring Farms Drain-Section 2 Arm

Attached is a petition, plans, non-enforcement request, calculations, quantity summary and assessment roll for the Section 2 Arm Spring Farms Drain. I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

6"	SSD	4,338 feet	21"	RCP	40 feet
12"	RCP	154 feet	24"	RCP	91 feet
15"	RCP	368 feet	27"	RCP	498 feet
18"	RCP	466 feet	30"	RCP	150 feet

The total length of the drain will be 6,105 feet.

The retention pond (lake) located in Block B, at the rear of Lots 36-41, 44 and 45 is not to be considered part of the regulated drain. Only the inlet and outlet will be maintained as part of the regulated drain. The maintenance of the pond (lake) will be the responsibility of the Homeowners Association. The Board will however, retain jurisdiction for ensuring the storage volume for which the lake was designed will be retained. Thereby, allowing no fill or easement encroachments.

The subsurface drains (SSD) to be part of the regulated drain are those located under the curbs. Only the main SSD lines which

are within R/W are to be maintained as regulated drain. Laterals for individual lots will not be considered part of the regulated drain. Existing SSD is located at the rear of Lots 62 to 66, and Lot 69.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I also believe no damages will result to landowners the construction of this drain. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$30.00 per lot, \$5.00 per acre for roadways, with a \$30.00 minimum. With this assessment the total annual assessment for this drain/this section will be \$ 1228.14

Parcels assessed for this drain may also be assessed for the Osborn-Collins or Williams Creek Drain at sometime in the future.

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

I recommend that upon approval of the above proposed drain that the Board also approve the attached non-enforcement request. This request is for the reduction of the regulated drain easement to those easement widths as shown on the secondary plat for Spring Farms, Section 2 as recorded in the office of the Hamilton County Recorder.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposed drain for October 27, 1997.

We hereby establish our Irrevocable Standby Letter of Credit No. A-545 in your favor, at the request and for the account of Bay Communities Limited Partnership and Bay Development Corporation, 7858 Bay Shore Drive, Indianapolis, IN, 46240, for any sum or sums not exceeding Eighteen Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$18,000.00), available upon presentation by the Hamilton County Board of Commissioners, enumerating any and all improvements and costs thereof not completed as required in Spring Farms Subdivision, Section II, Committee Docket No. 41-96 SP, for the performance of the installation of erosion control as required by and to be accepted by the Hamilton County Board of Commissioners.

The drafts drawn under this Letter of Credit, which are to accompany the related letters, must state "Drawn under Letter of Credit No. A-545 of Citizens Bank of Central Indiana dated September 10, 1996". The amount of the drafts must be noted on the back of this Letter of Credit by the negotiating bank and/or agency. A statement signed by the beneficiary shall accompany any draft presented outlining the specific areas of Bay Communities Limited Partnership and Bay Development Corporation, non-compliance with the requirements set forth by the Hamilton County Board of Commissioners.

This Letter of Credit is effective as of September 10, 1996 and shall expire on March 10, 1998, (date at least one year later), but such expiration date shall be automatically extended for a period of eighteen months on March 10, 1998, and on each successive expiration date, unless a release is received from the Hamilton County Board of Commissioners, or we notify the Hamilton County Board of Commissioners by certified mail, at least ninety (90) days before the current expiration date, that we have decided not to extend this Letter of Credit beyond the current expiration date. In the event of such notification by us, the credit established by this Letter shall be available to the Hamilton County Board of Commissioners upon its sight draft or demand for payment for ninety (90) days after receipt of such notice by the Hamilton County Board of Commissioners, as shown on the signed return receipt.

The credit established by this Letter and our obligation to pay same shall not be affected by the receivership, bankruptcy or insolvency of debtor or the attachment of his property. Nor shall this credit or our obligation to pay same be affected by any security agreement or other agreement between Bay Communities Limited Partnership and Bay Development Corporation and our bank and/or agency.

The 6" SSD total is now 4900 feet.


The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now **6672 feet**.

The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on October 27, 1997 as noted in Drain Book 4 page 463. The document has not at this time been found in the Recorder's Office records.

The bond or letter of credit from Citizens Bank, number A544 for storm sewers and subsurface drains, A545 for erosion control; dated September 10, 1996; in the amount of \$119,000.00 and \$18,000.00; was released May 11, 1998.

I recommend the Board approve the drains construction as complete and acceptable.
