RE: Springmill Streams Drain, Section 5

I have inspected the drainage facilities for the Springmill Streams Drain, Section 5 and have found them to be complete and acceptable. The Project Engineer has submitted the Certificate of Completion and Compliance and "As Built" Drawings on reproducable mylar of the drainage system.

No major changes were made in the construction of the storm sewer system within this section. However, slight changes were made in the subsurface drain (SSD) system. Instead of serving Lots 100 and 101 from the SSD in Section 4, the SSD was brought East from the open ditch along the South side of Brighton Avenue. Also the SSD which originally stopped at the South corner of Lot 90 was brought around along the North side of Brighton Avenue to serve Lot 89. The SBD's on the North side of Brighton Avenue West of Regent Circle and along the West side of Regent Circle are also an added portion to the regulated drain. The six (6") inch SSD now is 2730 feet in length and ten (10') feet of ten (10") CMP has been added. The new length of the drain is 3948 feet.

At this time I recommend the Board approve the drainage facilities as constructed. I further recommend that the non-enforcement request for this plat be approved by the Board.
