I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accuring to the owners of land likely to be benefitted. The drain will consist of the following:

The total length of the drain will be 3170 feet.

Only the main subsurface drain (SSD) will be maintained as part of the regulated drain. The branches for each lot will not be maintained as part of the drain. SSD along curbs will not be maintained as regulated drain.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$20.00 per lot, \$2.00 per acre for roadways. With this assessment the total annual assessment for the drain/this section will be \$516.42.

I recommend a hearing be set for January 1988.


