






Report of the Drainage Commissioners and Engineer.

To the Honorable Judge of Hamilton County.

We the undersigned Commissioners of Drainage and the Engineer,

to whom the above entitled petition for Drainage of certain lands,
in Jackson Township, Hamilton County, Indiana, was referred;

We would respectfully report that we met on the line of said pro-
posed repair, ^{a part} of said Wm Nagle , Drain, on the 25th day of

July 1921, qualified and proceeded to view said Drain and
lands affected thereby.

After a careful investigation of the condition of said Drain,
we are of the opinion that said Drain should be repaired, and in
the manner set out below in this report and that the same when com-
pleted will improve the public health and will reclaim certain lands,
and will be of public utility, and will benefit several highways,
also that the cost of construction and repair, damages and expenses of
effecting said Drain will be less than the benefits to the lands
affected by said Drainage.

That we have definitely determined the best and cheapest method of
effecting the Drainage of such lands, We have fixed the route, location
and character of said proposed work and have fixed the same by section
and boundary courses, distances, descriptions and guides, and Ranch Marks
including arms and branches so as to provide for a complete outlet for
the Drainage of said lands affected by said proposed work; that we
have divided the Ditch and branches into sections of not more than
100 feet in length by setting stakes at each 100 feet.

LOCATION.

THAT THE LOCATION AS FIXED BY US IS AS FOLLOWS:

Beginning at 15 feet South and 15 feet East of the Northwest corner of the intersection of Magnolia and North streets in the town of Arcadia, Indiana. and Run thence East in the North half of the roadway of North street, a distance of feet; Thence South 45° East feet, and terminating at a point feet South and feet West of the Northeast Corner of Section 24 Township, 20 north Range, 4 East,

Also an Arm, Beginning in the West half of the roadway of Washington street at a point 250 feet North of the North line of North street; and Run thence South 265 feet and enter Main Ditch at Station 11 plus 18 feet, of said main Ditch.

The work will be staked out by the Engineer and his stakes must be carefully preserved, and followed. The digging of each and every portion of the Ditch must begin at its outlet, or its junction with another tile Drain and proceed toward its upper end.

The Ditch to be dug along one side of the line of survey stakes, and sufficient distance from to not disturb them, and shall be dug in a ~~xxx~~ straight and neat manner. In taking out the last draft the blade of the spade must not go deeper than the grade line. The ditch must be dug accurately and true to grade at the depth indicated by the figures given by the Engineer, measured from the grade stakes.

The laying of the tile must begin at the lower end and proceed upstream. The tile shall be made of concrete and have ship-lap ends and must be laid as closely as practicable and in a line free from crooks, the pieces being turned about until the best connection possible is made. All tile used in the construction shall be first class in every respect, and shall be treated with waterproofing. All angles or turns in said drain shall be made at a manhole. Junctions with branch lines must be carefully and securely made. After the tile have been laid and inspected by the Engineer or his representative, they must be covered with the earth excavated from the trench, or borrowed clay or soil. Where said trench does not afford sufficient material the contractor shall at his own cost and carry provide sufficient clay and soil from some other source and in such case the depth of fill over the tile shall not be less than two (2) feet. Where the trench is all new cut, said trench shall be filled full.

And where said Drain is an open channel the filling shall be to a depth of not less than two feet above the top of the tile, for the full width of said channel, in no case must the tile be covered with sand without other materials being first used and in no case will boulders or heavy rock that may in time come in contact with the tile, be allowed in the filling. The ditch contractor must assume all risk from caving in of the Ditch, and when each drain is completed it must be free from sand and mud before it will be received and paid for in full. In case it is found impracticable, by reason of bad weather or other unlooked for trouble in digging the ditch or properly laying the tile to complete the work in the time specified in the contract, the time may be extended as may be mutually agreed upon by the Engineer and Contractor. The contractor shall use necessary precaution to secure his work from injury while he is constructing the drain. All tile and other material used in the construction of this drain and its tributaries thereto, included in the requirements of these specifications, shall be first class in every respect and subject to rigid inspection by the Engineer.

The Engineer shall have the authority to layout and direct the work, and to inspect and supervise the same during the construction and completion to see that it is done in accordance with the specifications and contract, and his instructions shall be fully carried out.

MANNER OF CONSTRUCTION & MATERIALS TO BE USED.

Beginning at the outlet of said drain or station 3~~+10~~ there shall be constructed a concrete retaining wall. The excavation for the drain to proceed up-stream through the entire job, as the excavation advances, the laying of the tiles shall follow by beginning at said outlet with 27" diameter Concrete tiles and continuing upstream to Station 20 and then 24" to station 11+18 then 18" to station 0 or the source. As the work of the tile proceeds concrete manholes shall be constructed at or near the different stations indicated on plat and namely stations 30-27-20-17⁺¹⁰-14⁺¹⁰-11⁺¹⁸-7-3-0-. All manholes to be built circular in form, 3' in diameter, and to a depth of drain at each different location, they shall have 6" walls to be tapered in at the top to receive 20" diameter rings and covers. All rings and covers to be of the McElwain Richards pattern or its equal.

At all street intersections, street drainage shall be provided be 10" Vitrified Sewer Pipe being connected to the manholes and extending to each corner of the roadway of said street crossing, to a depth of not less than 3' except at outer ~~wall~~ end, where same shall be brought to the surface by gradually elevating the last three tiles. Also at the manhole near station 30 a Vitrified tile inlet shall be put in and extend a distance of 30' west, also what is known as the W.F.Wilson drain shall be connected in to the manhole at station 20 by means of 18" tile.

The construction of the Branch shall be in the same manner as that of the Main Drain, by beginning at the Manhole at station 11+18 of Main Drain and extending north in Washington St a distance of 265' using 20" diameter concrete tile.

At station 0 of said branch shall be constructed a Reinforced Concrete Combined Connecting Box and Catch Basin, said Box to be 3' wide 7' long and 8' deep inside measure. Walls of same to be 6" thick, and to have openings at upper edge to permit water inflow. The Box to have 4" bottom and be covered 4" slab. In said slab shall be inserted Iron Ring and cover 20" diameter. Into this Box shall be connected the different tiles of the Wm. Nagle Drain that now outlet into old Catch Basin about 30' west stake 0 for which provision has been made in the estimate, said connections to be made with drain tiles of the kind and dimensions of the ones now in place.

In the programs of construction of both Main Ditch and Arm as each success-

sive tile is laid, the joint shall be wiped with a paste made from neat cement, and the tiles laid and joined together while said paste is still moiste and in a plastic state, after the tiles have been joined as specified, if should any opening in the joint appear it shall be sealed with a mortar of neat Cement or a mixture of one to one, of cement and fine sand.

Somewhere along the frontage of each and every abutting lot or tract of land, there shall be provided an opening for the connecting of the drainage from said lot or tract.

Said openings may be either Cut into the tile at the factory or on the Job, but in either case they shall be neatly Cut to fit the Size connection to be used by the property owner, But in no case to exceed the Size for an 8 inch Connection, without the consent of the Engineer,

Unless the property owner makes, his or her connection at the time said work is in progress abutting his or her property, the contractor shall proceed to Seal said opening before filling the trench,

He shall mould into shape, from a concrete mixture of One to Two, a plate, plug or stopper, of the shape and dimensions to suit the particular opening, and place said plate, plug or stopper in the opening and secure it with Cement mortar,


The location of each and every opening shall be perpetuated by measurement from some established point or line along said Drain.

CONCRETE WORK.

unless other wise specified all Concrete work included in these specifications shall be a mixture of 1-2-3 ; one part Portland Cement, Two parts sand, and Three parts gravel, The sand and gravel to be free from dirt, loam and other foreign matter.

The Cement, sand and gravel to be thoroughly mixed while dry until it presents an even shade of coloring throughout, then made into a moderately wet mortar, and be immediately placed in the forms for moulding the concrete into shape.

The forms for all concrete work shall be neatly constructed from strong materials, and shall be true to line, dimensions, and shape given for the different structures.
